



"MY WATER LOOKS CLOUDY"

Water from the tap may sometimes appear cloudy. This is due to a large amount of tiny bubbles in the water, the bubbles give the water a "milky" or "cloudy" colour. Air bubbles can get into the water stream while maintenance works are being carried out.

If a glass of cloudy water is left to stand the bubbles should disappear leaving a clear appearance. Cloudy water is not a health risk and is safe to drink

Cloudy water may also appear as frothy and splutter as it comes out the tap. Loud banging noises may be heard in the pipes and noise travels with the water as it comes out the tap.
